What an honor to be chosen Grand Marshall for Show and Go 2024. After being trapped in a woman's body for 9 months, McPeak was at an early age right here in Riverside CA in 1943. Going to local schools Poly and RCC he was fascinated by art. He meet the love of his life at RCC and was recognized as a man of distinction in the field of art award. He worked at a local sign shop for 8 years learning from the craft from Don Lloyd signs and that launched him into his next phase, selfemployment and McPeak Pinstriping. Influenced by Von Dutch, Ed Roth, Dean Jeffries and others he was inspired to open his own shop at home, and that morphed into a career as a custom painter, pinstriper, lettering artist and master who influenced and employed many talented craftsmen. McPeaks work is exhibited in many car shows, Riverside Art Museum, Ecology Center and Pick a Part. The business put him in touch with many Movers & Shakers of the day by lettering and striping trucks, race cars, boats, motorcycles and dune buggies. Along with anything else people brought to him. Thanks to the van conversion shops and car dealers, fame followed and even more business allowing him to buy the building he was rentina.

Back in 1957 McPeak was featured in Rod &Custom magazine with a model car he did. He was in 7th grade then. Many magazine articles followed his entire career. With his wife they raised 2 kids and has had homes in Newport Beach, Lake Arrowhead and here in Riverside. He has been able to travel to many of the states and many other countries which has been a life changing and fascination. McPeak was in the Air National Guard for 6 years and he has been inducted into the Route 66 Pinstripers Hall Of Fame along with Rubidoux High School's pinstriping Hall Of Fame. Life is good and thank you everyone for your generosity and support over a lifetime, cause without that nothing else could have been possible! Thank you all!! Mostly thank you Christine, my loving wife of 60 years.

How the cars are judged

Each judge looks and scores only one part of the car, so when they pass by the car, they are concentrating only on that part of your car. Each judge puts a raiting from 1-10 on his sheet for your car with a possible score of 60. These scores are then put into a computer and it will tell us who wins. The point spread for the Top 50 cars is usually within 15 points. We all build cars and appreciate the work and time you put into your car, but we have 3 hours to judge approximately 300 cars, so unfortunately we do not have the time to discuss your car. We thank you for bringing your car to the show and look forward to your return in the following years.

Outside watering in dry climates like ours in Southern California can be as high as 60% of your daily household water use. Riverside Public Utilities (RPU) is here to help with our water and money-saving rebate programs.

Weather-Based Irrigation Controller

Reduce Waste These "smart" controllers adjust irrigation schedules based on weather changes and needs of the landscape. They can reduce outdoor water use by about 20% percent. Rebates start at \$80 for controllers for less than an acre of landscape and \$35 per station for properties with more than one acre of landscape.

Increase Knowledge

Landscape Training Workshop Series

Learn how to manage your soil, properly program your irrigation controller, troubleshoot your irrigation system, convert traditional irrigation to drip irrigation, and remove and replace your lawn with low water use plants. For upcoming dates, contact RPU at (951) 826-5311.



Residential Turf Replacement Program

A typical household can reduce water usage by an estimated 60% by removing turf and converting your yard to water-efficient landscaping. Funding for the Residential Turf Replacement Program is supplemented by RPU above the base amount offered by Metropolitan Water District. The rebate amount has been increased to \$3 per sq. ft.
